

Drive Thru Flu Shot Clinic a successful endeavor



The Sioux Center Medical Clinic found a creative and convenient way to vaccinate community members. On October 15, medical clinic nurses and Dordt College student nurses administered 63 flu vaccines to people who drove through the clinic parking lot between 5 and 6:30 pm.

This year's vaccine is expected to be 70 – 80 percent effective and will last for six months instead of 3 months as in the past.
